CS: Uh—

WW: of 2007. The time is 1338 hours. This interview is in reference to Internal Investigation Number 07-FC-28 regarding an allegation of Criminal Conduct. Present for this interview is Inspector Joel DeCoursey, Jr. For the record would you please state and spell your full name?

CS: Cheryl Rene Stinson. C-H-E-R-Y-L R-E-N-E S-T-I-N-S-O-N.

WW: Do you understand this interview is being recorded?

CS: Yes.

WW: Do you understand that during the course of this interview there will be no unrecorded conversations concerning the investigation?

CS: Yes.

WW: In a previous interview you signed and reviewed the Confidentiality Agreement. Do you understand you're still bound by that?

CS: Yes.

WW: Please raise your right hand. Do you swear or affirm the information you are about to provide in this proceeding is the truth and nothing but the truth?

CS: I do.

WW: Okay, Ms. Stinson, in a previous in uh, interview regarding um, attending the Jail Administrators Workshop in last December—

CS: Uh huh.

WW: with Major Chapman.

CS: Yes.

WW: Specifically a dinner that was hosted and paid for by Prison Health Services. At that dinner could you describe where you sat in relation to where Major Chapman was seated?

CS: We sat across from each other at one of the ends of the long tables.

WW: So, kind of like we're sitting here now or--

CS: Yeah, the tables were setup straight in a row, uh, there were people sitted, seated on the ends, on the very ends and then we were on the last two at, at the one end right directly across from each other.

WW: Okay. At that dinner do you remember if Major Chapman I guess ate the meal or uh, partook of whatever was served that night?

CS: Yes.

WW: Do you remember what was being served that night?

CS: Oh, yeah, we ate a lot. We um, yeah, we had uh, hor d'oeuvres, and a salad entrée, and an entrée and a dessert, and drinks, and the, you know, there were quite of few choices.

WW: Okay. Do you have anything?

JD: Did he take anybody else with him um, while he was eating, like, his wife accompanied him at dinner or anything?

CS: No.

JD: Was there any unusual circumstances or incidents that occurred while at dinner? Anybody got, had too much to drink or was acting out that you can recall?

CS: No.

JD: Okay.

WW: Was alcohol being served at this dinner?

CS: Yes.

WW: Okay.

JD: I don't have anything.

WW: I can't think of anything else either. So, with that we'll end the interview. It's 1340.
